## SURVIVE AN ACTIVE SHOOTER EVENT

Call **911** from Any Campus Phone When You Are **Safe**.

Tell the 911 operator:

- + Your name
- + Your location (be specific)
- + Number of shooters
- + Description of shooters
- + Number of potential victims

## RUN



- + If there is an escape route, evacuate immediately.
- + Leave your belongings behind.
- + Do not try to move wounded people.
- + Prevent others from entering the area.

## HIDE



- + If you cannot evacuate, find a place to hide that is out of the shooter's view, protected from shots fired and non-confining.
- + Silence your cell phone/pager.

## FIGHT



- + If you cannot run or hide, fight back.
- + Be aggressive: Throw items, yell and improvise weapons.
- + Commit to your actions.

## COMPLY



When law enforcement arrives:

- + Remain calm and follow instructions.
- + Drop items in your hands.
- + Raise your hands and keep them visible at all times.
- + Do not yell, scream or point.
